- alliance** ..... an agreement between two or more countries, groups, or people to work together
- Allies (Allied Powers)** ..... countries (including Great Britain, France, and Russia) who supported each other during World War I
- assassinate** ..... to murder by surprise attack (especially a politically important person)
- Associated Power** ..... the status of the United States after April 1, 1917, during World War I
- Central Powers** ..... countries (including Austria-Hungary and Germany) who supported each other during World War I
- colony** ..... a region or country that is controlled by another country
- Great War** ..... another name for World War I (the name for the war during the fighting)
- imperialism** ..... the practice of establishing colonies; extending the rule of one country over other countries or colonies
- independent** ..... free from control of another; self-ruling

# Vocabulary

**militarism** ..... a country's desire to have a strong military

**nationalism** ..... loyalty and devotion to one's country

**neutral** ..... not taking sides in a quarrel or war

**Sarajevo (sah-rah-yeh-vo)** ..... a Slavic city in the territory of Bosnia; the place where Archduke Francis Ferdinand was assassinated on June 28, 1914 (which started WWI)

**treaty** ..... an agreement between two or more nations
