Remember, revising and editing are crucial steps to polish your research paper. Use this worksheet to guide your revision process and ensure effective communication of your ideas.

\*\*Content and Organization:\*\* - [] Is the thesis statement clear and specific? - [] Are the main points organized logically? - [] Do paragraphs have clear topic sentences? - [] Are transitions between ideas smooth? - [] Are arguments well-developed with evidence? \*\*Introduction:\*\* - [] Does the introduction provide context and background? - [] Is the thesis statement clearly stated? - [] Does the introduction engage the reader? \*\*Body Paragraphs:\*\* - [] Do each body paragraph focus on a main point? - [] Is each main point supported with evidence? - [] Are sources properly cited in-text? - [] Is there a balance between analysis and evidence? \*\*Conclusion:\*\*

- [] Does the conclusion summarize main points?
- [] Does the conclusion restate the thesis?
- [] Does the conclusion provide a thoughtful ending?

## \*\*Clarity and Style:\*\* - [] Are sentences clear and free from errors? - [] Have you avoided complex language? - [] Are there awkward sentences needing revision? - [] Is sentence structure varied for flow? \*\*Citations and References:\*\* - [] Are sources cited in required style? - [] Is a Works Cited/References page included? - [] Are citations consistent in formatting? \*\*Formatting and Presentation:\*\* -[] Is the paper formatted correctly? - [] Are headings used consistently? - [] Is spacing between paragraphs correct? - [] Is the title page (if required) formatted properly? \*\*Proofreading:\*\* - [] Have you proofread for errors? - [] Have you checked for homophones? - [] Have you read the paper aloud? \*\*Final Review:\*\* - [] Have you reviewed the entire paper?
