Accuracy of Answers (30 points)	30 pts: All answers are correct and demonstrate mastery of set theory concepts.	25 pts: Most answers are correct with only minor errors.	15 pts: Multiple incorrect answers that reflect partial understanding.	5 pts: Many incorrect answers with significant misunderstandings.
Calculations and Justifications (20 points)	20 pts: All set operations, calculations, and justifications are shown clearly and are accurate.	15 pts: Most steps and justifications are provided but with some gaps or minor errors.	10 pts: Several questions lack clear steps or correct calculations.	5 pts: Minimal attempt at showing work; steps are unclear.
Application of Set Operations (20 points)	20 pts: Set operations (union, intersection, complement, etc.) are applied correctly and thoroughly.	15 pts: Most operations are applied correctly with some explanation missing.	10 pts: Partial understanding or errors in multiple set operations.	5 pts: Most set operations are incorrect or incomplete.
Presentation and Formatting (10 points)	10 pts: Work is neat, logically organized, and submitted as instructed (Word or PDF).	8 pts: Minor formatting or organizational issues.	5 pts: Several formatting issues but work is readable.	2 pts: Work is poorly organized and difficult to follow.
