



How do we find context clues?

Look for clues in the text





Look for the definition of the unknown word in the sentence:

"Drew was ecstatic to be in school, which means he was happy to be there."



What does ecstatic mean?




Ecstatic means very happy




Look for these words to find an example:



"Matt enjoys completing science experiments, such as mixing elements to make new discoveries."







Experiment means to make new discoveries

"Daniel was eager or enthusiastic to answer the question."






Enthusiastic means being excited and eager



Find words that means the opposite of the unknown word:

"Olivia is very dedicated, unlike her older sister who doesn't try very hard."
