Integrates at least 8 Unit 3 vocabulary terms correctly, meets the word count, and extends analysis by exploring how the issue impacts different economic or demographic groups.	<b>24 pts</b> Article summary and/or analysis is clear, using most vocabulary words correctly. Mostly meets the required word count.	<b>18pts</b> Article summary and/or analysis lacks clarity or is missing <b>key vocabulary terms</b> . Somewhat under the required word count.	<b>12 pts</b> Article summary and/or analysis is unclear or lacks critical information. 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<b>Script Quality and Content Depth (20 pts)</b>	<b>20 pts</b> <b>Well-organized and clear.</b> Demonstrates a comprehensive understanding of the macroeconomic issue with an in- <b>depth analysis</b> that connects the article to broader economic trends and real-world implications for different groups.	<b>16 pts</b> Script is clear, but lacks depth or coherence in some areas.	<b>12 pts</b> The script is <b>unclear</b> , disorganized, or underdeveloped.	<b>8 pts</b> The script is poorly written, lacking clarity and depth.	<b>0 pts</b> No script submitted.
<b>Presentation or Animation (20 pts)</b>	<b>20 pts</b> Includes <b>2 dynamic visuals</b> that clearly enhance the explanation of the issue. Presentation is highly engaging, with <b>clear, confident narration</b> . Demonstrates depth by incorporating specific examples, economic group impacts, and supported claims using data or visuals.	<b>16 pts</b> Includes 2 visuals that mostly enhance the explanation. <b>Engaging</b> but lacks creativity or full visual support for the script.	<b>12 pts</b> Includes visuals but lacks clarity or strong integration with the script. <b>Unclear narration</b> or weak engagement.	<b>8 pts</b> Lacks relevant visuals or poorly integrated into the script. <b>Poor narration</b> , unclear or monotone voice.	<b>0 pts</b> No presentation/a nimation submitted.

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<b>Creativity and Engagement (15 pts)</b>	<b>15 pts</b> <b>Highly engaging</b> and creative use of visuals, narration, and transitions. The visuals significantly enhance the viewer's understanding.	<b>12 pts</b> <b>Good engagement</b> , but lacks creativity or visuals that don't fully support the script.	<b>9 pts</b> <b>Basic presentation/animation</b> with limited creativity, visuals underused.	<b>6 pts</b> Not engaging, lacks creativity, or poor visual support.	<b>0 pts</b> No effort to create an engaging presentation/animation.
<b>Clarity, Organization, Writing Quality, and MLA Citations (15 pts)</b>	<b>15 pts</b> Well-organized, clear, and coherent. <b>Proper MLA citations</b> used throughout (in-text and Works Cited). No grammar/spelling errors.	<b>12 pts</b> Writing is mostly clear, with some grammar/spelling errors. <b>MLA citations</b> mostly correct, with minor issues.	<b>9 pts</b> Writing lacks clarity or structure. Multiple grammar/spelling errors. <b>MLA citations incomplete</b> or contain errors.	<b>6 pts</b> Writing is difficult to follow. Numerous grammar/spelling errors. <b>MLA citations missing</b> or incorrect.	<b>0 pts</b> No writing submitted or <b>MLA citations entirely missing or incorrect.</b>
